- 2. We will walk together in love as Christ commands, caring for each other, watching over each other, and encouraging and admonishing one another as occasion requires.
- 3. We will regularly attend the church's gatherings and faithfully pray for one another.
- 4. We will work to lead those in our care through biblical instruction and correction, and seek the salvation of our family and friends.
- 5. We will rejoice at each other's happiness and bear each other's burdens and sorrows.
- 6. With God's help, we will live carefully in the world, denying ungodliness and worldly desires. Our symbolic burial and resurrection in baptism testifies to this special obligation to live a new and holy life.
- 7. We will work together to maintain a faithful gospel witness in our worship, ordinances, discipline, and doctrines. We will contribute cheerfully to the expenses of the church, the needs of our neighbors, and the spread of the gospel around the world.
- 8. If we leave this congregation, we will join another gospel-preaching church as soon as possible, where we can carry out the spirit of this covenant and the principles of God's Word.
